Individuals holding a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university, or satisfactory undergraduate academic achievement are preferable for application. Prior study in business or economics is not a requirement for admission.

1. Application Form

Create an account to login to “NTHU Online Application System” at Office of Global Affairs (OGA), NTHU website (<http://oga.nthu.edu.tw/>) to fill out the online application. Upload all the required application materials to the system. Please make sure that all application documents contain your full name. Once submitted, the application for admission and all supporting documents become the property of IMBA program of National Tsing Hua University.

2. A Photocopy of Diplomas/Certificates in English or Chinese

If the original language of the diploma or certificates is not in English or Chinese, a certified English translation must accompany with the original document. Students, who are in the process of completing their studies, must submit a letter from the school/university clearly stating your anticipated graduation date.

* If there is no the word “Bachelor” on your diploma/ certificate, it is necessary to submit a letter from your university clearly stated your undergraduate diploma is equivalent to the bachelor degree.

3. Official Academic Transcripts in English or Chinese

Please upload transcripts from all college, university or post-secondary educational institution (including dates & obtained degrees) to the online system. If the original language of the academic record is not in English or Chinese, a certified English translation must accompany with the original transcript. Official copies of credentials must be certified by a school administrative officer of the institution from which the degree was received.

4. A Study Plan in English

Describe your short-term and long-term study goals, and your future career plan.

* Double-space with a minimum font size of 10.

* No more than one A4 page.

5. Two Recommendation Letters in English

Two recommendation letters are required.

Fill out at least 2 referees’ emails on the online application form. Once the online application is completed and submitted, the online system will automatically send out the recommendation notice and the link to the referees. Preferably referees are faculty members who can evaluate your academic qualifications, work excellence, and research potential. To be clear, it is not necessary to be a professor as the referee instead of your employers.

*The information of the referees cannot be changed once submitted to the system.

6. Financial Statement

All applicants are required to provide financial proof that shows financial sustainability (minimum USD 4,000) for study in Taiwan, or proof of the scholarship, e.g., the bank balance with or the TaiwanICDF application form.

7. Declaration Form

Print out the declaration form (generated by the online application system) and sign at the bottom of the form after reading through it. If applicable, we may ask the applicant to submit a copy of the statement of travel record, or the “Forfeited Nationality Permit Certificate” issued by Ministry of the Interior and Non-Household Registration Declaration.

8. Verification of Nationality

Submit a copy of passport. If the copy of your passport is not available, you may provide other verifications of nationality.

9. Program Specific Requirements (as follows)

I. English Proficiency Test Result (required for **non-English** native speakers)

Applicants, whose first language is not English, are required to take an English proficiency test as a part of the application procedure.

II. Certificate of working experience (**preferable but not required**)

There is neither specific template nor format for the certificates, but with stamp or autograph from your supervisors or corporates.

Please provide any materials that will help the Admissions Committee in assessing the applicant’s abilities.

● NOTES

1. For ICDF program of IMBA, please note that applying for NTHU admission does not mean applying for the scholarship as well. You must fill in two application forms. One for the applied program and the other for TaiwanICDF scholarship. To access the TaiwanICDF scholarship application form, please refer to <http://www.icdf.org.tw/ct.asp?xItem=12505&CtNode=30316&mp=2> to fill out the forms, and send the other required documents to the ROC (Taiwan) Embassy/Representative Office.
2. It’s suggested to apply for International MBA in Technology Management program (TaiwanICDF) and International Master of Business Administration (IMBA) program simultaneously. In case of not receiving TaiwanICDF scholarship, the applicants still have a chance to be accepted by International Master of Business Administration (IMBA) program, and apply for other scholarships provided by NTHU, government institutions, or private organizations. 3. To complete the application, applicants must follow the above mentioned procedure. In addition, late or incomplete submission is not acceptable.

III. Application Deadline

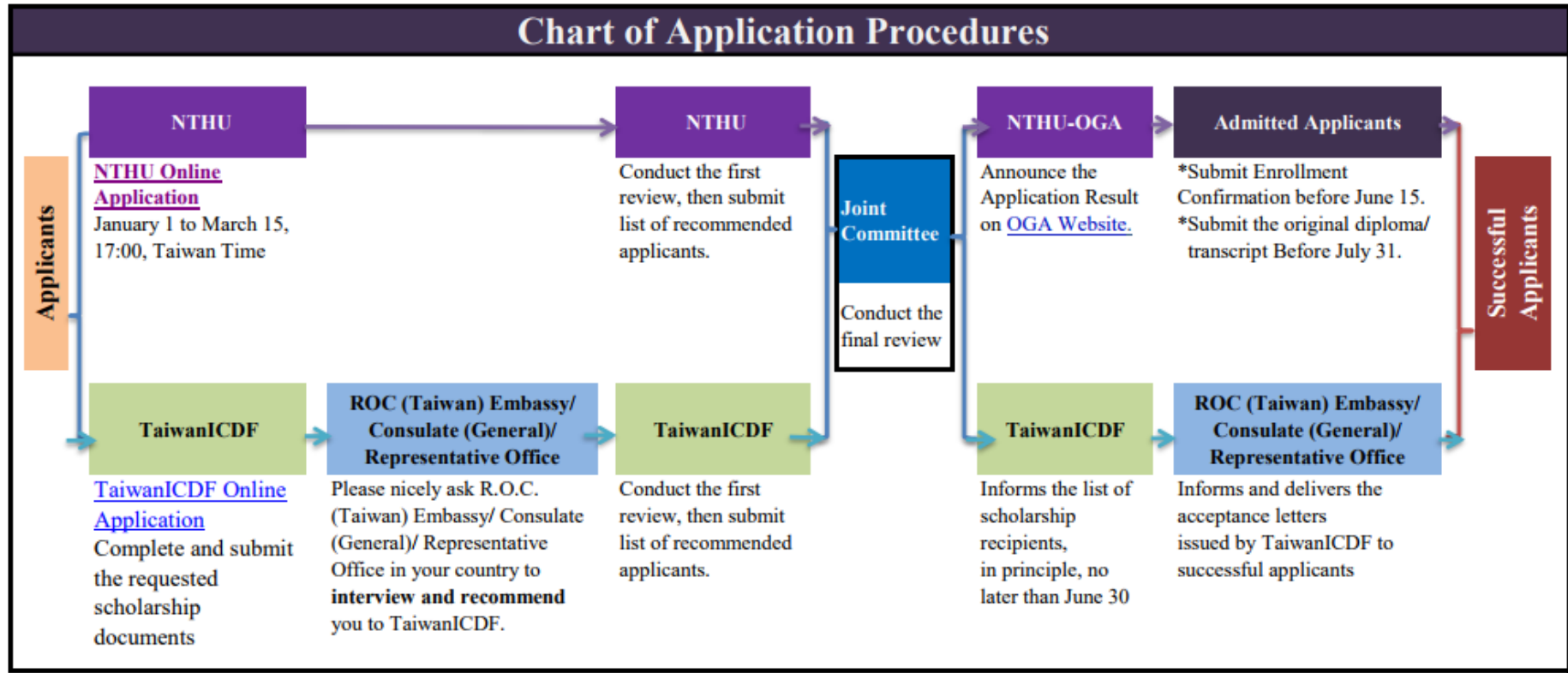
Application Period: January 1st to March 15th, 2020. 17:00. (Taiwan Time)

We only accept online applications. Please upload all application documents (PDF File only). The documents should be uploaded separately. If there is more than one file for each requirement, it is required to merge files into one for uploading. Applicants have to upload all application requirements and click on submit button to complete their application before the deadline. Applicants will be notified via e-mail after uploaded documents are checked. Late or incomplete submission is not acceptable.

General Eligibility Criteria for TaiwanICDF Scholarship

An applicant must:

- ✓ Be a citizen of a country on the List of Countries Eligible for TaiwanICDF Scholarship, and satisfy any specific criteria established by his or her country and/or government of citizenship.
- ✓ Neither be a national of the Republic of China (Taiwan) nor an overseas compatriot student.
- ✓ Satisfy the admission requirements of the partner university to which he or she has applied to study under a TaiwanICDF scholarship.
- ✓ Be able to satisfy all requirements for a Resident Visa (Code: FS) set by the Bureau of Consular Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and an Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) set by the Ministry of the Interior, of the ROC (Taiwan) government (this means that the TaiwanICDF has the right to revoke a scholarship offered if an applicant cannot satisfy the visa requirements).
- ✓ Upon accepting a TaiwanICDF scholarship, not hold any other ROC (Taiwan) government-sponsored scholarship (such as the Taiwan Scholarship) in the same academic year in which the TaiwanICDF scholarship would be due to commence.
- ✓ Not be applying for another TaiwanICDF scholarship in unbroken succession—to apply for a 2019 scholarship, applicants who have already held a TaiwanICDF scholarship, MOFA's Taiwan Scholarship or an MOE scholarship must have graduated before July 31, 2018.
- ✓ Have never had any scholarship revoked by any ROC (Taiwan) government agency or related institution, nor been expelled from any Taiwanese university.
